The agreement allows CGA’s and students to apply for admission to the distance delivery of the SAIT Bachelor of Applied Business Administration in Accounting and Information Technology program as follows:

\*Students must graduate from the program at their home institution and register as a CGA student with the appropriate region to obtain a transcript evaluation, prior to applying for admission to SAIT Polytechnic and enrolling in the final two Directed Field Study courses. SAIT will continue to offer all courses at the same frequency in the current schedule. It is anticipated that as enrolments decline, the number of course offerings will gradually be reduced. Advising through SAIT and the CGA regional offices will be available for students who require assistance in planning their schedule of studies in order to complete the degree by September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

SAIT works closely with business and industry to ensure that SAIT students learn relevant skills upon which to build successful careers. The SAIT degree offers relevant distance education programming in IT with an accounting focus, in direct response to the needs of industry. Although the degree program is being phased out, SAIT and CGA-Canada remain dedicated to supporting and accommodating SAIT degree students, and will continue to make you aware of revisions to the program.

During the current academic year of 2007-08, we are authoring new curriculum in Network Management, Database Management and Organizational Behavior for delivery in September and December of 2008. CGA Canada and SAIT will continue to revise courses and textbooks used in the program under an agreed revision schedule to ensure that students are learning from and working with leading edge material.
